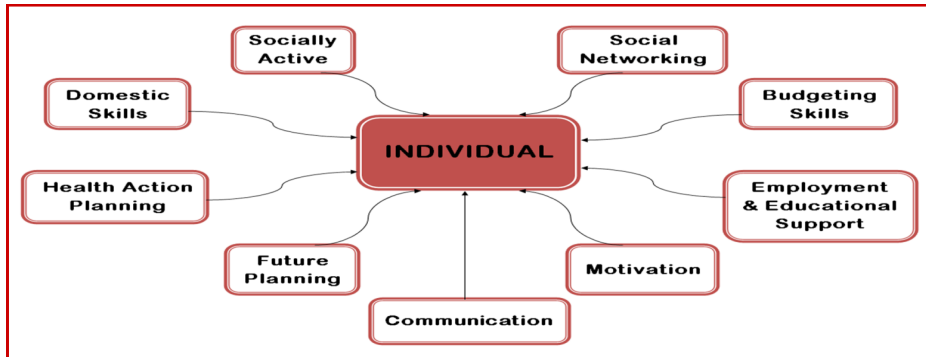


# POTENS PARK VIEW

**Chris's story..** Chris came to Park View after being in hospital for more than 2 years, during which time, he failed to interact with both ward staff and other patients, and isolated himself from all organised activities. When Chris moved into Park View, he lacked motivation in all areas of daily living, and would not engage in any community activities.

During a six month period, the experienced staff team have actively supported Chris to increase his self confidence and improve his daily living skills. He now enjoys a full and active life both within Park View and the local community. He cooks several times a week with support, and is once again taking great pride in his appearance. He has made contact with his family, and is concentrating on building new and lasting relationships.

**Support** can also be offered for clients on a Community Treatment Order or Section under the Mental Health Act.

**Staff** work in partnership with other concerned professionals to involve residents with local therapeutic resources such as CPN's, mental health clinics and substance misuse teams.
